President's Report

As 2018 comes to a close, let us celebrate our great community and the efforts of so many members who step up year after year to organize amazing events and activities!

Of particular note at this time of year are: the Social Committee for the always outstanding Holiday Home Tour; the Activities for Youth Committee for the highly successful and well attended Breakfast with Santa; the Adopt-An-Area Committee for spreading holiday spirit with decorations throughout the Hills; and the Chapel Committee for the beautiful Christmas Eve service. Events such as these contribute to making HAH a great place to live and play.

The HAH Board and the Management Committee send a huge thank you to all HAH members who contributed a record of more than \$17,000 to the Employee Christmas bonus fund! Your generosity to this fund enables us to recognize our valuable staff in a meaningful way for the outstanding contributions they make to this vibrant community.

You may have heard about the amenities allocation process

and wondered how it works. The Club's various amenities are supported in part with 50% of the new member fee that is collected each year when a house or lot is purchased. Members of the various Board-recognized committees develop proposals to improve and enhance HAH amenities such as the golf course, the pool, the chapel, and so on. (Many of the Club amenities are described on the Club's website).

Under the direction of the Long-Range Planning Committee, led by Ken Yost, the proposals are reviewed and, this year, \$141.200 was distributed to the Committees for 2019 projects. Examples of new projects planned are an expansion and upgrade of the Clubhouse kitchen, facility improvements to the donated Paniccia building across from HAH's front entrance, and landscaping improvements to the Pool area. The committees work together each year to put forth quality proposals that will benefit the community at large.

All the best in the New Year! I am hopeful and confident that 2019 will be another great year for us all.



At the December 18 Board of Trustee meeting, the trustees changed the load limit from 5 ton to 13 ton beginning February 1 continuing through April 15, 2019

General Rule #25

"Load limits will be placed on all roads during inclement weather to prevent damage to the roads. No vehicles in excess of thirteen (13) ton gross weight, will be permitted during such enforcement, except emergency vehicles or any vehicle approved by the General Manager. Penalty for violation of the load limits will be a \$500.00 fine to the member, per occurrence."



Snow Season in HAH

Members, please remember to remove all vehicles and/or any obstructions from our roadways on snowy days which could hinder our Maintenance Department from clearing the roads for us.

Not only will it keep our employees safe, but will also ensure no damage will be done to your vehicles/personal property.

The HAH right-of-way is defined as 20' from the center of the road. Thanks you for your cooperation.

Long Range Planning led by Ken Yost successfully coordinated the effort and \$141,200 was distributed to the Committees for 2019 projects. TREASURER'S REPORT - Tom Mathews

Total committee funds in the Vinton County National Bank on November 30, 2018 were \$130,066.37. Motion to approve made by Tom Mathews; second by Greg Ptacin – **Motion Carried**

MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT - Jim Kirk

- 2019 Depreciation List need BOT approval for the following:
 - ♦ Rotary Mower AR5 for the golf course \$65,200
 - ♦ ½ ton Truck for Maintenance \$30,000
 - * BOT requested a copy of the 2019 Depreciation list.
- USPS informed HAH they are having a problem at the Sugar Grove Mail House (front gate) with packages. There isn't enough room for all the packages!! They are taking the overflow to the Guard Shack which is making the package issue at the guard shack even worse. USPS recommends we build a bigger Mail House.....
 - Result of this overflow could be that all packages addressed to RR 1 Box XXX that won't fit in boxes available will need to be picked up at the Sugar Grove Post Office.
 - ♦ Randy checked with USPS about another row of large package boxes in the Mail House and the person responsible is on vacation until 1/2/19 but responded there should be boxes available at no cost to HAH.
 - * BOT requested the E-Blast give a couple days grace before sending packages back.
- HAH Load Limits law: Please approve changing from five (5) ton gross weight to thirteen (13) ton gross weight.
 - BOT approve this change 7-0
- Update concerning RFID type entry systems for back gates Three companies have met with us and are putting together proposals. Received quote from Silco \$88K. EPS will not be quoting new system. Still waiting for Signature Control to quote. Randy contacted another company out of Chillicothe to quote.
- Lodge Update:
 - ♦ Lodge held a very successful Thanksgiving Dinner with sales of \$3K.
